PILLAR 5: Unlocking The Power of Prayer

- > Prayer is personal.
- > Prayer is the means by which we can know God and God's will for our lives.
- > Prayer is not just an action, it's an orientation.
- > Prayer is a way of being in the world.
- > The Greek word most often used for prayer in the New Testament contains much deeper meaning than most believers realize.
- The word demands *surrender* and *consecration* on the part of the one making the request.
- ➤ The word prayer used in most New Testament texts is taken from the commonly used Greek word for prayer which is *proseuche*.
- This is a compound Greek word derived from the words *pros* and *euche*.
- > **Pros** = is a preposition meaning face-to-face. The idea conveyed by this word is one of intimacy.
- **Euche** = is a word that means a wish, desire, or vow

Speaking Principles

I. Confession 1.John 1:5-10

- To confess our sins in the truest sense involves despising the sin, being grieved by it.
- The God where you have fallen short. Be specific.
- Thank God for the forgiveness that is available.
- Ask God for strength to resist temptation.

II. Worship Psalm 145

- ➤ Worship is about expressing your love and adoration for who God is.
- The focus of worship is not on the hand of God, but rather on the face of God.

III. Thanksgiving Psalm 69:30

- We must express our gratefulness for all the things God has done for us.
- We have plenty of reasons to be thankful.

IV. Petition Philippians 4:6-7

- This is the opportunity to offer to God your personal requests.
- > Tell God what you want, no matter how insignificant it seems to you.



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V. Intercession Colossians 1:3, 9-14

- ➤ Intercessory prayer is the act of praying on the behalf of others.
- > The role of mediator was prevalent in Old Testament.
- ➤ In New Testament Christ becomes the ultimate intercessor.

Rom. 8:34; I Tim. 2:5

Listening Principles

VI. Be Still and Quiet Before God

- ➤ Discipline is the only way we can learn this principle.
- At times it might be good to have a change of scenery when trying to listen to God.

VII. Don't Hurry Your Time with God

- > God wants us to learn to wait before God.
- ➤ It is difficult to experience meaningful times with God if you are trying to rush God into your schedule.

VIII. Spend Various Seasons of Your Life with God

- > Don't just pray when you find yourself in a moment of crisis.
- > Prayer works best when we are consistent.
