### **Hope vs. Optimism**

- Optimism says, “Things will get better.”
- Hope says, “I don’t know if things will get better, but I will continue to hold on regardless.”

### **I. The Definition of Hope**

- Hope is a feeling of expectation and desire for a certain thing to happen.
- The Greek word for Hope is: *Elpis*
  - *Elpis* means: expectation, confidence, trust
  - The Triumphant Trinity:
    - *Faith*- revealed by what we believe.
    - *Hope*- revealed in our conviction that things will get better.
    - *Love* – revealed by our behavior.
