III. The Sheep in Luke 15:4

- ➤ We are sheep
- > Sheep sometimes wander away from the fold

Isaiah 53:6

Lost sheep have no place to rest

Jeremiah 50:6

We are in need of a shepherd

1 Peter 2:25

IV. The Search in Luke 15:4

- The shepherd leaves his flock to go find the lost sheep
- > Christ, as the Good Shepherd, searches for lost sheep
- > That was His whole purpose in coming

Luke 19:10; John 10:11

➤ He loves us like we were His only sheep

V. The Support in Luke 15:5

- > The shepherd took the sheep in his arms and carried it
- > Jesus will take us in His arms and carry us to safety

Matt. 11:28

➤ He has promised to never leave us nor forsake us

VI. The Shout in Luke 15:5b-6

➤ Shout = Leaping, Dancing, Rejoicing

Psalm 107:1-2

- > The shepherd rejoiced
- > The friends and neighbors rejoiced
